



Mr. Victor Levinson. It is with deep and profound sadness that we share that Victor Levinson, devoted husband, dedicated father, adoring grandfather, dear friend, trusted advisor and lifelong learner, died last Saturday May 28, 2022. He was 81. Vic will be terribly missed by his wife Jane; their children, Nick, Lynn and Tom - and their spouses, Julie, Roderick and Elizabeth; his grandchildren, Nate, Zack, Owen, Emma, Ben, Asher, and Estelle; his brother Warren (Barbara); and many friends.
